AUSTRALIAN GOVERNMENT DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE, FISHERIES AND FOESTRY QUARANTINE REQUIREMENTS AND INFORMATION

Australia's quarantine regulations applicable at the time of the vehicle's entry have to be complied with – quarantine clearance must be obtained from the Australian Quarantine and Inspection Service (AQIS) after the vehicle has arrived at the port of entry.
